There has been some community **call for action** around the 'real time' buoy alarms at select outer Cape beaches. When a White Shark tagged by Mass. Department of Marine fisheries (DMF), swims into the zone, lifeguards are alerted and take appropriate action. The real coverage gap has been after guarded hours. We were approached by a local innovator who has crafted a solution so that after guarded hours, alerts can sound to those people in the water, more to come.

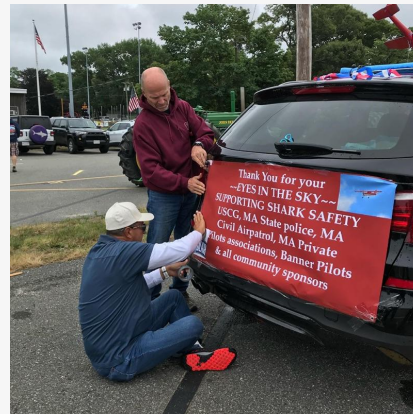
